# Referrals

A doctor or therapist's referral is preferred; however, clients can self-refer. Patients over the age of 18 at any point of the continuum of care are welcome to submit a referral.

Once a referral is submitted you will be contacted to learn more about your EADL goals and book an initial assessment appointment. During this appointment you will receive a full physical and functional assessment by our clinicians and trial equipment to improve your quality of life.



# What Are EADLs?

Electronic Aids to Daily Living (EADL) are electronic devices used by individuals which enable them to interact with their environments (home, work, and school). Devices can include:

- Telephones (i.e. voice or switch activated)
  - Accessible solutions from wheelchair or bed
- Call bells for alerting care givers
  - Door openers
  - Bed Controls
- Household Light Operators
- Accessible TV or Media Remotes
  - Page turners for E-readers
  - Other adapted solutions



# Funding

Please note that the Ministry of Health and Long Term Care does not provide financial assistance for EADLs; consequently, ATC's EADL program is offered on a fee for service basis. In some cases, subsidies are available; however, funding may also be available from third party agencies, or private insurance. Should funding assistance be required, application assistance can be provided by ATC.
